Tennis Court Rules and Regulations

Effective Date: May 18, 2025

The following rules and regulations govern the access and use of the tennis courts for residents and recreational membership owners of Village Green in Farragut, TN. These guidelines are in place to ensure the safety and security of all residents and common areas.

1. Access

- Access to the tennis courts is restricted to residents of Village Green Subdivision who are current on their dues as well as individuals that have purchased a recreational membership.
- Additionally, residents and rec members can bring one guest at a time

2. Tennis Instruction

- Residents and rec members are authorized to hire any tennis instructor of their choosing, and the tennis instructor is authorized to have access to the courts as a guest.
- In the event that a tennis instructor is a resident or rec member, they are not allowed to provide instruction unless hired by a resident or rec member.
- No paid instruction of non-residents or non-rec members is allowed without the approval of the Village Green HOA Board of Directors.

3. General Rules

- Play must be limited to one (1) hour when others are waiting. Doubles are suggested when courts are crowded.
- No skates, skateboards, muddy shoes, bicycles, or other toys with wheels are allowed on the courts.
- Children under the age of 13 are not allowed to play on the courts unattended.
- Damage to the finish of the courts due to misuse can result in a fine of up to \$250 to help pay for repairs.
- Put all trash in the garbage cans and turn off court lights when not in use.
- Do not lean on or strike the nets in any manner.

- Only tennis shoes may be worn on the courts.
- The courts close at 11:00 PM unless otherwise notified.
- League and other special activities may be approved by the Board of Directors, and these activities will take priority over all other play.
- No pets allowed.

4. Pickleball

- Pickleball is allowed to be played with appropriate pickleball equipment only.
- Pickleball games cannot take up more than one tennis court at a time.
